Power Drill with 1/4" Drill Bit Grease Pencil or scribe No. 2 Phillips Screwdriver 8mm Wrench Block of wood to fit between the fender and tire



PREPARATION:

Position motorcycle securely on its sidestand.

Clean Fender

The front fender tip extends down past the edge of the fender when installed.Note: where fender will fit into position. Figure 1.

Squeeze in on the fender, position the Fender Tip. Figure 2.

Make sure the Fender Tip is symmetrical and is tight against the fender.

Mark the hole locations on the fender using the grease pencil or scribe. Remove the tip. Figure 3.

With the wood block between the Fender and the tire, drill a 1/4" hole through the fender at the marked locations. Figure 4.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Position the Fender Tip in place on the front fender so the holes align.
- 2. Place the Phillips screws through the Fender Tip and fender. Add a washer at the back. Thread the nut onto the screw. Figure 5.
- 3. Tighten the screws securely. The nuts should be tight enough to avoid rattles.
- 4. Check the tightness of the nuts after about ten miles of riding.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE: Clean and polish with a chrome cleaner/polish. Check tightness of the nuts regularly.


